- **Kearney Children's Museum** — inspiring curiosity and learning in young Kearney families
- **Museum of Nebraska Art (MONA)** — preserving and celebrating Nebraska's artistic heritage
- **Kearney Area Community Foundation (KACF)** — building long-term community strength
- **Himachali Foundation** — Nepal — supporting school education for children in need
- **Water for Haiti** — providing clean water access to communities in Haiti
- **Rotary Polio Plus** — the global campaign to eradicate polio worldwide
- **Rotary Children of the Dump** — Nicaragua — supporting children living in extreme poverty
- **Rotary RotoPlast** — providing cleft palate surgery to children who could not otherwise afford it

- **Choose Your Level of Support.** For the first time, sponsors may choose to sponsor multiple pairs of aluminum cranes, allowing businesses, organizations, and individuals to make a contribution at the scale that is right for them.
- **Select Your Location.** Sponsors may choose the permanent installation location of their cranes from available City of Kearney light pole sites — placing your legacy exactly where it matters most to you.
- **Choice of Artist.** Work with our team to identify the perfect artist and location for your crane installation. If you have a specific artist in mind, let us know. This will allow the COP4 Committee to facilitate an inspired pairing. Either way, your cranes will be a one-of-a-kind work of art.
- **A Permanent Collection.** These aluminum cranes will be installed permanently throughout Kearney — not displayed temporarily, not auctioned away, but permanently placed as an enduring part of the Kearney community for years to come.

The Kearney Dawn Rotary Club is thrilled about the permanent collection that Cranes on Parade 4 will create across our city. Imagine your name — or the name of someone you wish to honor — permanently associated with a beautiful, hand-crafted work of public art gracing the streets of Kearney for generations. This is a lasting impact, a visible reminder that our community believes in beauty, generosity, and the power of art to bring people together.
